

Developmental Disability Registry (DDR) Identity Card

Overview

The Developmental Disability Registry (DDR) identity card aims to help cardholders with disabilities integrate into society and live independently, as the information on the card helps members of the public identify and extend appropriate assistance to the cardholders. The DDR identify card bears the contact information of cardholders' caregivers, and social service agency they are receiving services at, for the public to help cardholders return safely if needed.

Who can Apply

Applicants should be:

- Singapore Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Certified to have one or more of the following permanent disabilities:
 - Physical disability
 - Deafness/ hard of hearing
 - Visual impairment
 - Intellectual disability
 - Autism

The DDR identity card was first introduced to persons with developmental disabilities; eligibility has since been extended to all persons with disabilities.

How to Apply

Please apply through any of the DDR-registered agencies (Please refer to **Appendix A**). If you are not a client of any of the DDR-registered agencies, you can approach Bizlink.

- The DDR identity card is administered by SG Enable on behalf of Ministry of Social and Family Development.

 - i. The card is not transferable and may only be used by clients who are issued the card.
 - ii. The card has no cash value.
 - iii. The card must not be altered, tampered or modified in any manner.
 - iv. Lost or stolen cards must be immediately reported to the registered social service agencies that had issued the card.
 - v. The card remains the property of SG Enable and must be returned upon request. Misuse of the card may result in termination of the card without refund or compensation.
 - vi. SG Enable reserves the right to modify the structure, use and other features of the card, including these terms at any time. Use of the card by a cardholder will be deemed as acceptance of any amendment to the terms and conditions of the card. SG Enable will not be liable for loss or damage resulting thereof.
